

## Harry B. Gray Travel Award Application

The Harry B. Gray Travel Awards will provide support for University of Cincinnati 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> year Department of Chemistry graduate students working in the field of inorganic chemistry to attend national meetings in the field of chemistry. The awards (up to \$250) will help to defray registration, travel and accommodation costs beyond those covered by a GSGA travel grant.

Candidates with demonstrated enthusiasm, initiative and intellectual curiosity should apply. Students who have never attended a national meeting and students who will not be presenting are strongly encouraged to apply. Students who have previously presented at a national meeting as a graduate student are not eligible. National meetings include the semiannual ACS national meetings, and others. Applications are due to Dr. Connick one month before the start of travel.
